eService Adapter Now Uses Platform TransactionId

A platform generated TransactionId is now being utilized to send to eService for bit 127.2 instead of a random GUID so that it can easily be looped back in a follow on transaction, as the TransactionId is logged throughout the platform.

eService Transaction Responses Received

When AMQ was unreachable, eService transaction responses were being lost. The AdaptorUtility component of the eService AddIn has been modified to allow multiple configurations. If AMQ is unavailable, the request will be written directly to the database. The AdaptorUtility also has been updated to read from the queue first, looking for a response; if a response is not found, then it will read from the database.
