1. Updates to Continue Supporting Card-On-File Transactions

Updates were made to accommodate additional requirements for Card-On-File transactions discovered during certification.

2. Include TxnGUID for All Transactions Though NGTrans

In accordance with compliance standards, all transactions through NGTrans will include a new mandatory field for the TxnGUID.

3. NGTrans EMV Tag 8A Changes

If it's returned in the response, <SuccessRespData> or <ErrorRespData><EMVDataResponse><AuthRespCode> should always be mapped from EMV Tag 8A first. If EMV Tag 8A is **not** returned, then:

- * Map NGT_NETWORK_CODE to <AuthRespCode> for all card types except AMEX
- * For AMEX, map the last 2 positions of EMV Tag 91 to <AuthRespCode>
- * Continue to map EMV Tag 91 to <IssuerAuthData> for all card types
