Enhancements & New Features

The .35R2 release was focused on enhancing support for 3-D Secure 2.0:

Exemptions and Out of Scope Transactions

Support was added for Exemptions and Out of Scope transactions where a Challenge is unlikely to be required, thus ensuring the highest rate of Frictionless transaction processing for Merchants. More details on Out of Scope transaction types and Exemption categories can be found under the relevant workflow pages on the EVO Snap Doc Portal.

Protocol Support

Due to the many roles in the Authentication workflow, Snap* has added logic to submit the highest mutually supported protocol in an Authentication request. This will guarantee the highest chance of a successful Authentication. Note that only the Full Flow and As a Service workflows support this feature. The current release supports the following protocols: 1.0, 2.1, and 2.2.

Follow-On Transaction Support

For Authorize and Capture and Authorize and Undo transaction workflows, Authentication only occurs on the Authorize part of the transaction. However, the 3-D Secure Authentication information returned on the Authorize response are required on the follow-on transaction requests, such as Capture, ReturnByld, and Undo. Support was added to internally map Authentication data on the Response for those follow-on transactions.

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Cards Not Enrolled in 3-D Secure 1.0 Prevented from Processing

Improvements were made to disallow cards not enrolled in 3-D Secure 1.0 from being processed. Now, transactions will be declined until the Merchant-defined 3-D Secure rules that apply to both 1.0 and 2.0 protocols are in place.
